**Ballot Title:**

Right of Intimate Privacy

**Ballot Summary:**

Guarantees the Right that No Act of Sexual Intimacy Committed in Private between Consenting Adults shall be Prohibited by Law. Repeals Florida Criminal Laws including those Banning All Oral Sex Acts and All Sex Acts between Unmarried Persons. Does not Repeal Laws Regulating Sexual Acts for Economic Compensation.

**Full Text:**

Article I of the Florida Constitution is hereby amended by adding the following section. Right of Intimate Privacy.

A. No act of sexual intimacy committed in private between consenting persons above the age of majority shall be prohibited by law.

B. Legislature can regulate sexual acts for economic compensation.

C. If any portion of this section is held invalid for any reason, the remaining portion of this section, to the fullest extent possible, shall be severed from the void portion and given the fullest possible force and application on the day after approval by the electorate.
