

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PETITION FORM

FLORIDIANS' RIGHT TO BE PROTECTED FROM DANGEROUS CRIMINALS

Under Florida law, it is a first degree misdemeanor to knowingly sign more than once a petition or petitions for a candidate, a minor political party, or an issue. Such offense is punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. [Section 104.185, Florida Statutes]

TITLE: Keep Felons Away From Guns!

SUMMARY: Protects law abiding gun owners' rights. Establishes terms for gun sales, Compiles list of felons legally possessing firearms, Requires registration, Proscribes safety measures and Clarifies existing law.

FULL TEXT: Article 1 of the Florida Constitution is hereby amended adding the following Section 27: Keep Felons Away From Guns. Legislature shall prescribe and enact measures implementing this Section 27: I. Floridians' Right to Be Safe From Dangerous Criminals. Legislature shall proscribe and enact the provisions of this amendment.

- A. All convicted felons must be informed that they cannot own guns, regardless of whether adjudication was withheld or not.
- B. All suspected, convicted, and charged felons will be put on a list open to the public, including names from the national list.
- C. A system to monitor active arrest warrants must be implemented to immediately trigger notification to law enforcement agencies and licensed gun dealers in the state, restricting the further sale of firearms and ammunition, pending outcome of the warrant.
- D. Enact anti-gun trafficking laws, require registration of secondary sales, and ban military style assault weapons.
- E. Develop a state system to automatically identify and disarm felons and others prohibited persons who bought guns legally in the past, but later became ineligible.
- F. Gun registration must be mandatory so that police may trace guns used in crime and identify illegal gun traffickers.
- G. Gun manufacturers must provide ballistic fingerprints to law enforcement agencies.
- H. Increase the penalties imposed for private party sales to dangerous criminals.
- I. The Attorney General must establish a plan for implementation of a new system. In developing the system, the Attorney General must consult with the Secretary of Treasury, other States, and local law enforcement officials with expertise in the area, and other experts. The laws should be clear and in conformity with those of New York and California and 18 U.S.C.S. Section 922.
